CORPUS CHRISTI - Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist: The Eucharist is the Sacrament which contains the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, together with His Soul and Divinity, the entire living and glorified Christ, under the appearances of bread and wine. The Council of Trent clearly defines the truth that is the very foundation of all Christ-life and worship: "In the Most Holy Sacrament of the Eucharist there is contained truly, really, and substantially, the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, together with His Soul and Divinity, indeed the whole Christ." As Catholics we believe that Jesus Christ remains personally present on the altar as long as there is a consecrated Host in the tabernacle. He is the same Jesus Christ, true God and true Man, Who walked the streets of Galilee and Judea. We believe that He actually comes as our personal guest every time we receive Holy Communion. The Eucharist is one of the seven Sacraments since It contains Christ Himself, the Divine Author of the Sacraments. There are three different aspects or phases of the Eucharist. The first is called the Real Presence of Christ on the altar while there remains a consecrated Host in the tabernacle. The second phase of the Eucharist is the Sacrifice of the Mass, and the third is Holy Communion. The word "Eucharist," from the Greek, means "Thanksgiving." It is applied to this Sacrament because our Lord gave thanks to His Father when He instituted It, and also because the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the best means of expressing our thanks to God for His favors. The Holy Eucharist is the very center of Catholic worship, the heart of Catholic life. Because the Church believes that the Son of God is truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, she erects beautiful churches and adorns them richly. The Sacrifice of the Mass is not only a ritual which reminds us of the sacrifice of Calvary. In it, through the ministry of priests, Christ continues till the end of time the sacrifice of the Cross in an un-bloody manner. The Eucharist is also a meal which reminds us of the Last Supper, celebrates our unity together in Christ, and already now makes present the Messianic banquet of the Kingdom of heaven. In the Eucharist Jesus nourishes Christians with His own Self, the Bread of Life, so that they may become a people more pleasing to God and filled with greater love of God and neighbor. The Eucharist is reserved in our churches to be a powerful help to prayer and the service of others. Reservation of the Blessed Sacrament means that at the end of Communion the remaining Consecrated Bread is placed in the tabernacle and reverently served. The Eucharist reserved is a continuing sign of our Lord's real presence among His people and spiritual
