LEGION OF MARY: Meet every Thursday, at 10:00 a.m., in the parish hall. We welcome new members.

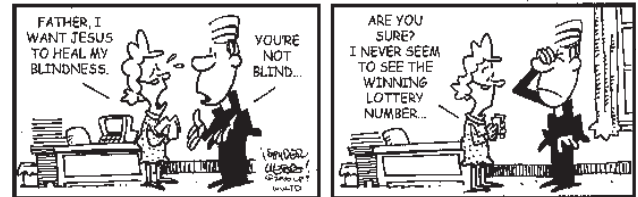

YOU DID IT FOR ME: Creation is a gift. What we do with this gift has major impacts for future generations. Our Holy Father reminded us during his visit to the U.S., "When it comes to the care of our common home, we are living at a critical moment in history." How will you care for this gift and protect it for future generations? Catholics across the country are taking steps to care for our common home and making sure that God's gift of creation is not spoiled for our children. Start now by heeding Pope Francis' call to take action.

Q We have a small parish that shares a priest with three other parishes in the area. While this has not yet happened, I was wondering if there were no priests available for Mass, would it be considered a sin to miss Mass?

A The Catechism teaches us that serious or mortal sin requires three conditions: grave matter, full knowledge and deliberate consent. (CCC 1857). Obviously, in the situation you described there is no choice or control in the matter. A priest is either available or not. This can happen even when the priest is normally available but on a given Sunday is sick or away. It would be a different story, however, if the priest at your parish was unavailable, but you could attend Mass at a close neighboring parish.

In the eastern part of the country, we have many ethnic based parishes and people who refer to parishes as the Italian or Polish parish. Ethnic ties are not an excuse. As a church that is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, ethnic histories are part of our history, not the definition of the church. So, in answer to your question, common sense rules. If a priest is just not available, there is no sin and we are not responsible. If we have an opportunity to attend Mass and choose not to, we are responsible and therefore sin.
